

Millers put Bellefontaine's Holland Theatre up for sale

BELLEFONTAINE - A Logan County landmark officially went up for sale Oct. 12 when the Holland Theatre closed after 67 years of operation in downtown Bellefontaine.

Owners Rodney and Becky Miller of Jackson Center darkened the five screens featured in the theater for the last time the evening of Oct. 11. The theater first opened in 1931 featuring a decor styled after an actual street scene in Holland.

The complex includes offices along the west side of the building. The Millers hope efforts to restore the theater to its original glory go on.

Rodney Miller explained non-profit organizations could take over the landmark and seek grants for restoration that are not available to businesses.

Theaters owned by the Millers in Jackson Center, Kenton and Ada continue in operation.
