

Contract Is Let For New Theatre On Bank Street

\$50,000 Structure in Ottawa South Being Constructed for F. W. Robertson.

Contract has been awarded to T. C. James for a new motion picture theatre, to cost approximately \$50,000, which will be erected on the southwest corner of Bank street and Euclid avenue, in Ottawa South. The theatre is being built for F. W. Robertson, former owner of the Fern Theatre.

There will be seating accommodation for 634 persons in the new theatre, which will comprise a building having a frontage of 65 feet on Bank street, running back for a depth of 99 feet.

There will be three stores on the Bank street front in addition to the entrance to the theatre. It will be a building more than a storey in height, to allow for the gallery to extend over the ceiling of the stores on the front.

Plans for the new theatre were drawn by J. P. MacLaren, architect. It will be constructed of concrete, brick and steel, the floor of the auditorium to be of concrete.
