

# Sheboygan Theatre Sold

Purchase of the Sheboygan Theatre and four other state theaters in the Stanley Warner chain was announced today by Ben Marcus, president of Marcus Theaters Management Co. of Milwaukee.

In addition to the local movie house at 826 N. 8th St., other theaters involved in the transaction include the Warner in Milwaukee, the Venetian and Rialto in Racine, and the Appleton in Appleton.

owned by the Stanley Warner Theaters chain, also is included in the announced purchase.

Although no purchase price was given, it was reported to be a \$2-million transaction.

Ralph Schallow, manager of the Sheboygan Theatre, had no immediate comment on the reported sale.

With the acquisition of the properties from the Stanley Warner Theaters Chain, the Marcus circuit will expand to 47 mid-west theaters, including seven showhouses and some 25 drive-ins in the Milwaukee area.

Marcus said he planned to spend \$500,000 to completely remodel all offices in the Warner building.

Marcus heads the Pfister Corp. which recently completed a \$7 million expansion and remodeling program at the downtown Pfister Hotel in Milwaukee. He also is president of a corporation operating 13 restaurants (Marc's Big Boy) in Wisconsin.
