Even the wonders of a modern liner would pale beside the new Blackpool Winter Gardens, which have just been completed, and where synthetic "sunshine," so realistic that one lives in continual expectation of a rainbow, spreads warmly over a Spanish court-yard with the wooded hills of Andalusia peeping above the terraced verandah.

Covering six acres of land are banqueting and reception rooms, such that 2,000 people can be served with a

five-course dinner at one time.

There is a restaurant in the Italian Renaissance period, another in the Georgian design, a baronial hall of the English Carolean period, and a galleon refreshment lounge.
